IMPORTANT — PLEASE READ BEFORE PROCEEDING

Before proceeding with registration and payment for an Adventure Motorcycle Course operated by Tasman Motorcycle Training, please read the following Participant Acknowledgement of Risk and Terms carefully.

By selecting the required agreement checkbox and submitting your registration, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to these terms.

1. Inherent Risks

Adventure motorcycle riding and associated course activities involve inherent risks. These risks may include, without limitation:

- **Falls and collisions**
- **Loss of control of a motorcycle**
- **Loose, uneven, steep, slippery, narrow, unstable, muddy, rocky, rutted, or otherwise hazardous terrain**
- **Water crossings**
- **Changing weather, temperature, light, and visibility**
- **Natural hazards and animals**
- **Obstacles**
- **Road, track, or other riding hazards**
- **Mechanical or equipment failure**
- **Fatigue**
- **Contact with other riders, vehicles, instructors, staff, landowners, or members of the public**
- **The acts or omissions of other participants**

These risks may arise from:

- **The nature of the activity**
- **The riding environment**

- **Equipment**
- **Other people**
- **Circumstances beyond the reasonable control of Tasman Motorcycle Training**

2. Potential Consequences

I understand that participation in an adventure motorcycle course may result in:

- **Serious injury**
- **Permanent disability**
- **Death**
- **Damage to or loss of my motorcycle**
- **Damage to or loss of protective equipment**
- **Damage to or loss of personal belongings or other property**
- **Financial loss**

3. Voluntary Participation and Acceptance of Risk

I choose to participate voluntarily and acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with the course to the maximum extent permitted by law.

4. Fitness, Eligibility, and Disclosure

I confirm that:

- **I am physically and mentally fit to participate safely in the course**
- **I will disclose any injury, illness, medical condition, medication, impairment, or other matter that may reasonably affect my safety or the safety of others**
- **I meet the stated course eligibility requirements**
- **I hold any licence required by law for the motorcycle and location in which I ride**

5. Alcohol, Drugs, and Impairment

I will not participate while affected by:

- **Alcohol**
- **Illicit drugs**
- **Medication that may impair my ability to participate safely**

- Any other condition that may impair my judgment, reaction time, physical or mental ability, or safe operation of a motorcycle

6. Rider Responsibilities

I agree to:

- Wear the protective equipment required by Tasman Motorcycle Training
- Ride within my own ability and experience
- Maintain control of my motorcycle
- Comply with applicable laws and course rules
- Follow the reasonable safety instructions of instructors and staff
- Promptly notify staff if I feel unsafe, unwell, unable to continue, or become aware of a hazard

I understand that I am responsible for making safe decisions about my own participation and riding.

7. Provider's Role and Course Removal

I understand that Tasman Motorcycle Training will take reasonable steps to provide the course with reasonable skill and care but cannot eliminate all risks inherent in adventure motorcycle riding.

Tasman Motorcycle Training may refuse, pause, modify, or end my participation if staff reasonably believe that I am:

- Unsafe to participate
- Impaired
- Medically unfit
- Insufficiently equipped
- Unable to meet the course requirements
- Unwilling or unable to follow reasonable safety instructions

Where reasonably practicable, staff may provide instructions or assistance to help manage the situation safely.

8. Release to the Extent Allowed by Law

To the maximum extent permitted by law, I release Tasman Motorcycle Training, its directors, officers, employees, contractors, instructors, agents, landowners, and course partners from liability for loss, damage, injury, death, or expense arising from the inherent risks of my participation in the course, except to the extent that liability cannot legally be excluded or limited.

9. Consumer and Statutory Rights

Nothing in these terms is intended to exclude, restrict, or modify any rights or obligations that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted, or modified.

This includes applicable rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 and any other applicable New Zealand legislation.

10. Emergency Assistance

If I am injured or become unwell, I authorise Tasman Motorcycle Training and its staff to arrange reasonable:

- **First aid**
- **Medical assistance**
- **Emergency transport**
- **Other emergency action they reasonably consider appropriate**

I understand that I may be responsible for costs not covered by:

- **ACC**
- **Insurance**
- **Another party**

11. Use of Participant Information

I consent to Tasman Motorcycle Training collecting and using my personal and emergency-contact information for purposes including:

- **Course administration**
- **Safety management**
- **Emergency response**
- **Communicating with me about my participation**
- **Other purposes described in the Tasman Motorcycle Training Privacy Policy**

12. Acknowledgement and Agreement

I confirm that:

- **I have had a reasonable opportunity to read these terms before submitting my registration and payment**
- **I have understood their general effect**
- **I agree to be bound by these terms by selecting the required agreement checkbox and submitting my registration**

13. Registration, Payment and Booking Confirmation

Submitting your registration and accepting these terms does not guarantee or secure a place on the course.

- Your registration will be treated as provisional until full payment has been received by Tasman Motorcycle Training.
- Payment must be made by bank transfer using the account details provided after registration.
- Full payment must be received within 48 hours of submitting your registration.
- Your place on the course will only be confirmed and secured once full payment has been received.
- If full payment is not received within 48 hours, Tasman Motorcycle Training may cancel your provisional registration and release the place to another participant.
- Tasman Motorcycle Training is not required to hold a place beyond the 48-hour payment period.
- If your provisional place is released due to non-payment, there is no guarantee that a place will remain available.

14. Cancellation

- We understand that sometimes plans change. The course fee includes a **\$50 non-refundable portion**.
- If you need to cancel **before 7 November**, we'll be happy to provide a refund, minus the \$50 non-refundable portion.
- **From 8 November onwards, unfortunately no refunds will be available.**
